Rally Field Information

- Aerial Points located at rear of Electrical hook-ups (cables available for sale 10, 15, 20 Meters)
- Water points located on green bollards adjacent to moorings.
- Elson located end of driveway / grey water to young trees or hedgerow.
- Waste/Recycling are supplied on the main field.
- Laundry facilities available on site £3.00 per wash (please see Lisa or John) for tokens.

Site rules and guidelines

- The route through the boat yard is only our right of way and therefore we do not own it, could we please
 ask all visitors to Avon Bank Meadow to keep to the 12-foot gravel track and not to stop or deviate from
 the route under any circumstances, we also ask that you stick to the strict 5MPH limit, please do not walk
 around boats or slipway.
- Rally start and finish times are as agreed by your club however any days in between start, and finish dates we must ask that you depart before 11.30am and arrive no earlier than 12.30 pm.
- To enable us to keep the grass in good condition we do not allow ground sheets including breathable.
- Should the grass become wet during your stay please do not attempt to move there is a free tow out available and should be arranged between the marshals and John or Lisa.
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on lead and all mess picked up.
- There are dog walks either left or right out of the marina entrance (Do not use field between boatyard and site or the grass in front of the boats as dog exercise areas).
- We have boats moored on our property so please respect their privacy.
- Fishing is available when boats are out and there is a space or alternatively in the meadow next to the marina. (please speak to john or Lisa)

Local Information

- We do have places of interest and local information available please ask Lisa or John for more info.
- Our village pub **The Anchor Inn** is a lovely riverside pub with a great atmosphere and is only a short walk from Avon Bank Meadow.
- The historic market town of Pershore is just a 20min walk left out of the boatyard along the lane and then joins the river path that takes you into the town Pershore offers a wide range of shops, cafes pubs and restaurants and a beautiful Abbey set in large grounds grounds.
- There is a CO-OP a short drive away located on the industrial estate on the way to Pershore (open late).
